Simplifying Modifiers

How can such a small identifier create so many payment challenges? All of the CPT modifiers have a unique purpose, and used incorrectly can either deny payment, or pay claims in error, resulting in recoupments and payer inquiries. Surgical modifiers have many similarities, yet independent in their specific application. Unbundling of services through improper use of modifiers is a compliance risk, and affect payment associated with the Medicare Correct Coding Initiative.
